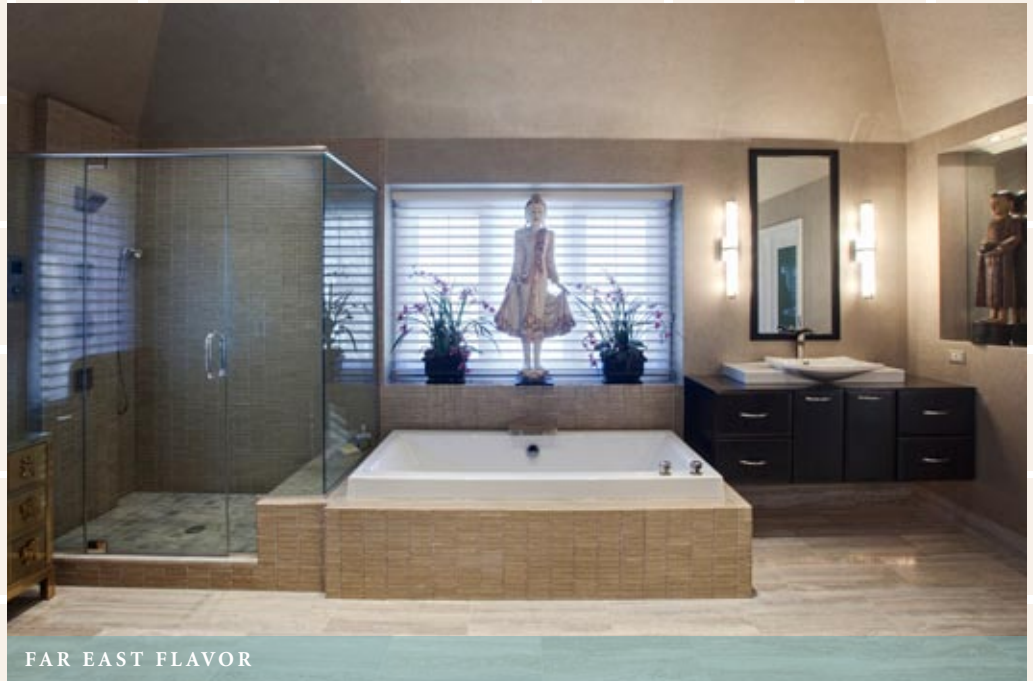


### Did you know October is National Kitchen & Bath Month?

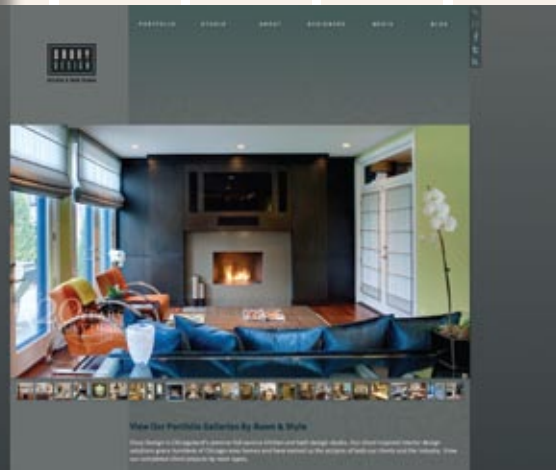
